Things you need to know when attending the Food Worker Card Classes:

Class is 90 minutes. No admittance after class begins – they mean it, doors are shut and locked
There are no breaks during class. Cost for the card is \$10 cash only, nothing larger than a \$20 bill, lease
No food or drink allowed in the classrooms, except water
If you are renewing your card, please bring the expiring card to the class
Cell phones and pages must be turned off during class
