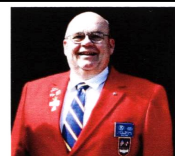
### February Division Council Meeting Cancelled!

Some of or clubs may be required to file the Form 990 or Form 990-EZ with the Internal Revenue Service each year. If so, you can find copies of the forms and filing criteria by going to: <http://pnwkiwanis.org/PNWKIResources/clubadmin.html> and clicking on the link labeled "Tax Filing (U.S.) - Form 990 & 990-EZ.

In general, clubs are only required to file this form if they have gross receipts (to include all administrative and service income) in excess of \$25,000 or if they receive a tax form package from the IRS.

Please note that the filing deadline for the 2004-2005 administrative year is February 15, 2006. Clubs may also file IRS Form 8868 to obtain an automatic three month extension, if needed. That form and instructions can be found at <http://www.irs.gov/pub/irs-pdf/f8868.pdf>

### **NEWS ABOUT ONE ASPECT OF THE GOVERNOR'S PROJECT**

**Hello All Club Leaders,**

Following is the quilt specifications for the governor's project for Camp Eyabsut located at North Bend, WA. in July, 2006. Finished quilts should measure approximately 3'x5' ( lap quilts), 100% cotton quilts (pre-washed and machine dried fabric) Machine washable and dryable when finished. Bright colors result in " happy quilts" Quilts may be machine quilted or hand-tied as long as the ties are 100% cotton. No glitter, fleece, corduroy or flannel( the fibers may inhibit the healing process)

Division 32 is looking to be the leading division in Governor Steve Emhoff's quest to provide quilts for burn survivors at camp. I think we happen to be a great division and could be the leader. I have been in contact with a few people will to help us and with all the clubs in the division. I know we can meet, and pass, the challenge. I am sending a letter to Diane Coombs as she has some contacts that can help us with some of the materials, she also is involved with a group of quilters that have done this type of project.

In speaking with Larry he felt that if we can get people to make the quilts that he would ask the clubs to help with the material. Also when we know how may quilts are made I need to contact Governor Steve so that he can send us the patches to sew on them.

The quilts are to be given to Larry at the upcoming council meetings.

I look forward to having all the clubs get involved and make this a memorable event.

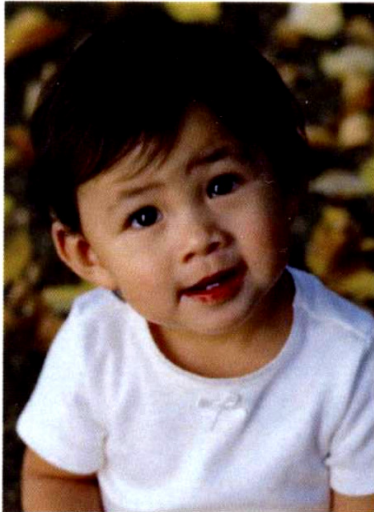
