Christmas Party

This year's Christmas Party is at the Tulalip Resort & Casino! The party starts at 7pm on December 12th.

Here are the guidelines for this year's Gift Exchange:

Value of the gift should be about \$15

Men – bring a gift for another Man

Women – bring a gift for another Woman

The exchange will work the same as usual – everyone draws a number, then the person with #1 picks the first gift. After the first gift is selected, the next person can either take a new gift, or pay \$1 to steal someone else's gift. Gifts are retired after they have been traded 3 times. Proceeds of the Gift Exchange will go to our Admin Fund.

Club Reminders:

- Dues need to be paid by the end of the year. \$50 bi-annually or \$95 annually. Make sure to pay your dues by December 31st to avoid being dropped from the club Roster.
