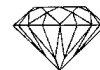

2 eggs	2 tsp B. Soda
1 tsp Cinnamon	½ tsp Nutmeg
1 tsp Salt	Hot oven: 350 degrees

Mix dry ingredients in a bowl; in another, mix pumpkin, sugar, milk & eggs. Mix both bowls of goodie together, along with butter & nuts. Pour in a greased pan and bake for 45-55 minutes.
